

PROCESSES



Positive/Delta

Purpose:

To collect, share, and celebrate positive activities and ideas that are working in the school community, and to brainstorm ideas and activities that could be introduced or changed.

Materials:

Flip chart paper and markers

Time for Process:

Approximately 20 minutes

Process:

- 1. Divide the participants into groups of 4 to 6.
- 2. Ask each group to create a t-chart on the flip chart paper. Have them draw a positive (+) symbol on the left side and delta (Δ) symbol on the right side.
- Groups will brainstorm all of the positive things that are happening in the school community that contribute to comprehensive school health, and write them in the positive column.
- 4. Ask each group to share their top three celebrations
- 5. As a group, brainstorm all of the healthy school changes that the group would like to see in the school community and write them in the delta column.
- 6. Participants will rotate to the other groups' flip charts to see all of their positives and deltas.

Next Steps:

The dotmocracy process can be used to prioritize the desired changes that have been identified by the groups. The ideas brainstormed can be used to adjust or create a healthy school action plan.
